SCPGA Junior Tour PARBREAKERS PROGRAM Donor Pledge Form

PAR BREAKERS was created as an opportunity for family and friends to support our junior golfers. Juniors are encouraged to receive pledges from family and friends to support each Eagle, Birdie, or even Par that they score during any SCPGA Junior Tour event during the Spring Series (January 1 - May 31, 2011).

This is a great way to encourage your junior golfer to achieve their goals. It is recommended that donors consult with the junior they are supporting as to their personal goals on the number of pars/birdies/eagles they would expect to make.

Juniors will benefit from the pledges they receive, as 50% of the pledge money they collect will be returned to the junior as a credit to their SCPGA Junior Tour account, and may be used to register for tournaments. The remaining 50% will be used to support the SCPGA Foundation and the many growth of the game programs it supports, including scholarships and grants. Donors have the option of also supporting the SCGA Foundation's "Youth on Course" program, which provides opportunities for low-cost access to golf courses and driving ranges for eligible juniors. Both the SCPGA and SCGA Foundations are 501 (c)(3) non-profit organizations.
